We need more responsible minerals and more ecological restoration

- There are a few remining or restoration companies out there. **We're the first to do both.**
- **Legacy mine sites are an opportunity.**
- What is viewed as waste can be a resource as new demand for minerals, coupled with technological innovation, unlocks value and supports the energy transition, restoration, and community backed closure.
- We address and reduce environmental and social liabilities in company closure portfolios and at OAM sites for communities and governments.
- Legacy sites become an environmental and community assets; a source for biodiversity and carbon credits and minerals that are **biodiversity, community, and climate positive.**

We reposition legacy mine sites as a novel source of responsible minerals.



Regeneration is the innovation

- Regeneration was established in October 2021 as a public-benefit corporation. **We use revenue from remining to restore habitats and biodiversity.**
